Tokyo University of Agriculture (Tokyo NODAI) was founded in 1891 as the first private higher education institution specialized in the field of Agriculture in Japan. In 2021, we are celebrating our 130th anniversary. The field of our research and education have been expanding in reflecting the demands of the society of the time. Today, it conforms 6 faculties/graduate schools and 23 departments which cover a wide range of areas, including bioscience, food science, natural science, health science, energy and regional regeneration.

The founding spirit “Return Students to the Farm” is succeeded till nowadays, which places value on our educational principle “Practical Science”, an approach that emphasizes practical exercises over theories.

The number of students is approximately 13,000 and over 550 academic and administrative staff members are supporting them. We have 3 campuses across Japan: Setagaya campus in Tokyo, Atsugi Campus in Kanagawa, and Hokkaido Campus in Abashiri, Hokkaido. In addition, we have 4 farms in subtropical to cold regions, Marine Research Center, and a Practical Forest for field practices which allow students to learn in diverse environments.
