



Hokkaido University

Hokkaido University (HU) was established as Sapporo Agricultural College in 1876, and is currently a comprehensive university with 12 undergraduate schools, 21 graduate schools, and 25 research institutes and centers.

HU was selected for the Top Global University Project in 2014. As the world's top-level research hub, HU established the Global Institution for Collaborative Research and Education (GI-CoRE) in 2014, and the Institute for Chemical Reaction Design and Discovery (ICReDD) in 2018. In order to develop next-generation leaders, HU provides students with high-quality education in a global environment through Nitobe College, Hokkaido Summer Institute, and Learning Satellite.

Strengthening our commitment to exchange with institutions in Russia, HU has led “HaRP” and “RJE3” initiatives which place a high priority on promoting people-to-people exchanges and fostering aspiring researchers. The satellite office in Moscow, which opened in 2019, has also taken on an important role in deepening partnerships with Russian universities.

HU has contributed to local and global sustainability for over 20 years. It is highly evaluated as the top university in Japan in THE Impact Rankings.
