Kanazawa University

Kanazawa University originated in 1862 as a smallpox vaccination center and became a university in 1949. Over the course of its 150-year history, the university has developed as a core comprehensive university under the university charter of "a center of education and research open to the region and the world" and has made significant contributions to the development of higher education and academic research in Japan.

With the establishment of fourth academic area, "the College of Philosophy in Interdisciplinary Science" in April 2021, we have 4 colleges, 7 graduate schools and 1 united graduate school, in which over 10,000 students are able to develop their learning more flexibly and freely to fulfill their mission in the international community. This image of human resources is defined as Kanazawa University Global Standards. Kanazawa University also promotes world-class research by establishing international research centers. These include the Newly launched Nano Life Science Institute, which has been adopted by MEXT as a World Premier International Research Center Initiative.
