Establishment of double degree program in the field of disaster and radiation medical sciences

**Abstract:**

Through the Fukushima Daiichi nuclear power plant accident in March 2011, it was revealed that we currently face a shortage of experts, including nurses and public health nurses, in the field of disaster and radiation medical science. In 2016, Nagasaki University (NU) and Fukushima Medical University (FMU) established a new master course program in the field of radiation medical sciences.

Furthermore, we started the new project for the establishment of double degree program between Nagasaki University, Fukushima Medical University and North Western Medical University (NWMU). In 2018, we held the joint seminar in NWMU, and students of NU participate in. Also, students of master course of NWMU will participate in the lecture in NU, and in February 2019, master course students of NU and FMU will participate in the lecture of Statistics in NWMU. Since 2020, we organized the training course for students in Kawauchi village, Fukushima Prefecture. In this autumn, we are going to start double degree program in the field of disaster and radiation medical sciences, which will be one of the models for global education system in this area.
