Application Guideline for the School Year 2024 Scholarship Programs for Privately-financed International Students

The process of evaluation and nomination by Niigata University for the School Year 2024 Scholarship Programs for Privately-financed International Students will be carried out according to this application guideline. The scholarship programs include MEXT scholarships for international students living in Japan, JASSO honors scholarship, and other private scholarship funds.

In this solicitation, we will determine the order of priority for recommending students for multiple scholarships. Applicants will not be notified of the ranking or selection results all at once. After the screening, if there are any applicable scholarships for the next academic year, the university will contact you in order to recommend them. Please respond when contacted by the University Email at a later date.

Applications are accepted only once a year (there will be no secondary application period). Students who wish to be nominated for SY2024 scholarship programs must apply during the set application period. Those who did not apply during this time will not be considered for nomination for the SY2024 scholarship programs.

Nominations wil also be made for scholarship programs for international students for the school year 2025, including KDDI Foundation's, Heiwa Nakajima Foundation's, and SATOYO Foundation's. (These programs are expected to be announced from July to September 2024 and their application periods will end before the opening of the next year's application period set by Niigata University.)

1. Eligibility

A student who will be granted a "Student" visa for his/her stay in Japan after April 2024 and who also meets the following conditions (1) or (2), and (3) is eligible to apply. Condition (4) must also be met by applicants to whom these conditions apply.

- (1) A privately-financed non-Japanese student who is admitted to Niigata University as a degree-seeking student in School Year 2024.
- (2) A student who plans to take an entrance examination to a graduate school between August of 2023 and March of 2024. However, it only those who are enrolled in the university at the time of application for this recruitment are eligible to apply.
 - In addition, if the result of the entrance examination does not allow admission as a regular student in April 2024, the student will be excluded from the recommendation order.
- (3) A student who is not scheduled to receive other scholarship grants in School Year 2024, or a student who is scheduled to receive scholarship grants in School Year 2024 and the amount of grants will not exceed 50,000 yen per month.
- (4) A student who is married and lives with the spouse is eligible to apply if the annual income of the spouse does not exceed five million yen.

6. Interview Dates

Interview sessions are scheduled on Monday, November 6 and Tuesday November 7, 2023.

Applicants will be informed of the specific time, date and venue of their interview sessions at a later date.

Applicants who want to take the interview in English must tell interviewer about it before the interview starts.

Applicants must inform the International Office in advance in the case that his/her interview schedule is not convenient. If applicant is absent from the interview without notice, he/she will be disqualified for nomination of scholarship.

7. Notification to the Applicant

Applicants who have been nominated for a scholarship program will be provided with application details of a scholarship program through the Student Affairs Section of their faculty by the end of October 2024.

8. Other Notes

- (1) Applicants will be informed only through their university email address, thus they must check email carefully.
- (2) If applicants and/or their spouses are currently receiving other scholarship grants such as scholarships by MEXT, foreign governments, private foundations or enterprises, the information must be correctly provided on the application form. If applicants have been awarded MEXT scholarship grants by the Japanese government, the period of scholarship grants must be reported.
- (3) An applicant may be removed from the nomination list if it is deemed that the applicant has not provided all the required information on the application form or that he/she has provided false information.
- (4) There is no guarantee that all applicants will be nominated for scholarship programs or that nominees will be selected as a scholarship recipient.
- (5) Interview sessions will be conducted via Zoom. You will need a web camera and sound device that works for two-way communication.
